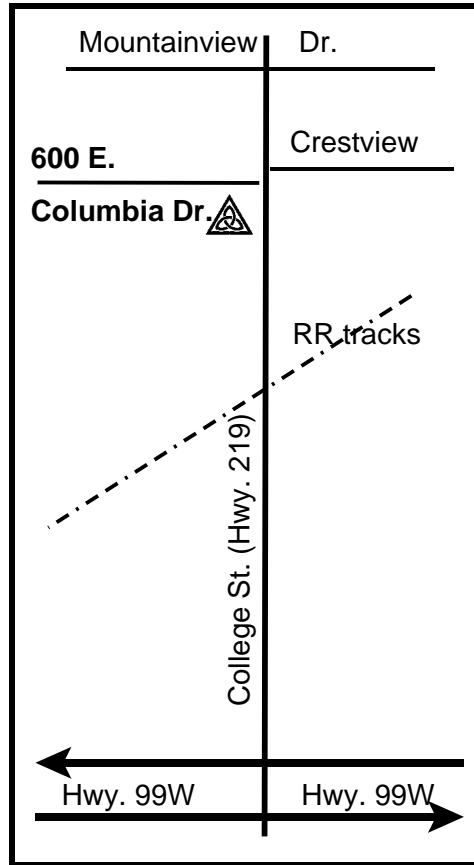


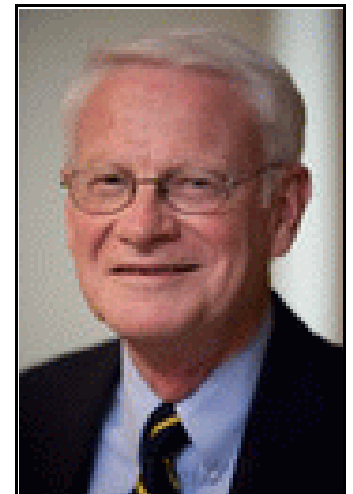

The Rev. Richard B. Gaffin, Jr., Th.D., is Professor of Biblical and Systematic Theology, Emeritus, Westminster Theological Seminary, Philadelphia. He has just retired from teaching at that school, where he served from 1965 to 2008.

His teaching has touched the lives of countless students, as is evident in the Festschrift recently published in his honor: *Resurrection and Eschatology: Theology in Service of the Church*. Also see the website created in connection with that volume:

He is the author of the following books: *The Centrality of the Resurrection* [= *Resurrection and Redemption*]; *Perspectives on Pentecost*; *Calvin and the Sabbath*; *By Faith, Not By Sight: Paul and the Order of Salvation*; as well as numerous articles and chapters in other books. He is in high demand as a speaker in the Orthodox Presbyterian Church and internationally as well.
